- Be knowledgeable of the Church governance system
- Be familiar with general parliamentary procedures
- Be willing to participate in discussions/dialogues
- Have the ability to manage confidential items
- Have an open mind to the opinions of others
- Have experience in local church governance
- Have a multi-cultural vision of the Church
- Be a problem-solver / solution oriented

In addition, be available on evenings (7:00 – 9:00 PM) both on weekdays and sometimes Sundays, whenever decided by committee.
